Number of third-party skills available for Amazon's virtual assistant Alexa



I. FAQ about Volara

What is Volara? Volara provides the software that connects voice interactions to the staff and services of the hotel through interactions such as "Alexa, ask the [hotel name] to bring towels to my room?" or "Alexa, ask the [hotel name] where I can get some sushi?"

What can I do with Volara? You can make requests of, and get recommendations from, the hotel. "Alexa, ask the [hotel name] to bring me a toothbrush?" or "Alexa, ask the [hotel name] can you recommend a place for a casual dinner?"

Things to Try

Learn how to use the Echo!

"Alexa, talk to the The Alexis."

Requests

"Alexa, ask The Alexis for more towels?"

"Alexa, ask The Alexis to bring a toothbrush to my room?"

Hotel Information

"Alexa, ask The Alexis where I can find the pool?"

"Alexa, ask The Alexis what time is breakfast?"

"Alexa, ask The Alexis what time is checkout?"

Concierge Recommendations

"Alexa, ask The Alexis where I can get a casual dinner?"

"Alexa, ask The Alexis where I can get a drink around here?"

Volara "Terms of Use"

"Alexa, pair Bluetooth"

"Alexa, play"

"Alexa, next"

"Alex, stop"

"Alexa, volume <6>" "Alexa, pause"

"Alexa, turn it up"

"Alexa, softer" "Alexa, resume"

"Alexa, mute"

"Alexa, play the program <Radio Lab> on TuneIn"

"Alexa, play the station <KEXP> on TuneIn"

"Alexa, play the podcast <Soundcheck> on TuneIn"

IV. FAQ about Privacy

Can I turn off the microphone on the Amazon Echo device?

Yes, you can turn Amazon Echo device's microphone off by pushing the microphone on/off button on the top of the device. When the microphone on/off button turns red, the microphone is off. The device will not respond to the wake word until you reactivate the microphone by pushing the microphone on/off button again.

Is Alexa recording everything I say? No. The Echo device uses on-device keyword spotting to detect the wake word and only the wake word. When the wake word is detected, the light ring around the top of the device turns blue to indicate that Alexa is streaming audio to the cloud. You can turn the microphone off by pushing the microphone button on the top of the device, which will turn on a red ring to indicate it's muted.

Can I review or delete my voice recordings?

Amazon only stores the audio recordings after the Echo device detects the wake word, along with a fraction of a second of audio from before the wake word was said. These audio recordings from the Amazon Echo device in your room are not associated with your name or other personal information. The hotel does not have access to any Alexa voice recordings from your stay.

Does Amazon store voice recordings from the Echo device? Yes, voice recordings are stored in the cloud in order to improve the service and to make the product better for our customers. Alexa is designed to get smarter every day. When you say the wake word, your subsequent phrases are processed and stored in the cloud to train and
